"How To" Green Screen With Do Ink

Checklist of what you need:

- ☐ Background picture(s) or video(s) saved to the photo app on the iPad
- ☐ A script of what is going to be said in the video
- \Box The green screen set up somewhere with space around it
- ☐ The person/people speaking can NOT be wearing green clothes!

Step One

Make sure you have all of the things from the checklist above. Choose the person or people who will be speaking and film them in front of the green screen.

HINT: Make sure that you zoom in enough so that all you see is them and the green screen. Anything else that shows up in the screen will cause the green screen not to work.

It's okay if you have to do the filming in several "chunks".

Step Two

Open the Do Ink app. Click on the + button on the upper right hand side.

Click "Create a New Project"

Step Three

Add your background image by clicking on the bottom + (Bottom = Background). Choose Image and you will be taken to the Camera Roll. Choose your Image. Or, choose Video and go to the Camera Roll to find the video.

Step Four

Now add the green screen video you have already taken! Click on the middle + (MIDdle = VIDeo). Choose the green screen video that you've taken. If you've taken more than one, choose the first one.

If you need to change either the video or the image, you need to tap on it in the timeline until it gets a RED box around it. To get the tools you can use to show up, tap the box again.

Step Five

Once you are happy with the way things look, click the word SAVE. Choose to save the video to the picture file for now.

Troubleshooting!

If you are having trouble, the first thing you need to do is identify what the problem is. Then click on the? in the top right hand corner. There's LOTS of information there!

The other thing you can do is go back and watch the video I showed you.
